Every Child Deserves a 5th Birthday

A child under the age of 5 dies every 6 seconds around the world. Since 2000, the global under-5 mortality rate has decreased by 51%. However, 4.9 million children still lose their lives before reaching their fifth birthday, with most of these deaths concentrated in sub-Saharan Africa. To ensure that every child reaches their fifth birthday, UNICEF prioritizes the most vulnerable children and delivers comprehensive support in nearly 190 countries and territories, providing health, nutrition, water and sanitation, education, and protection services.

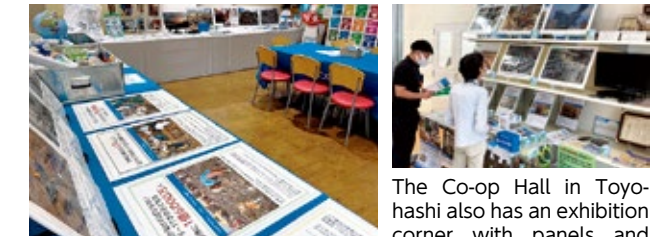

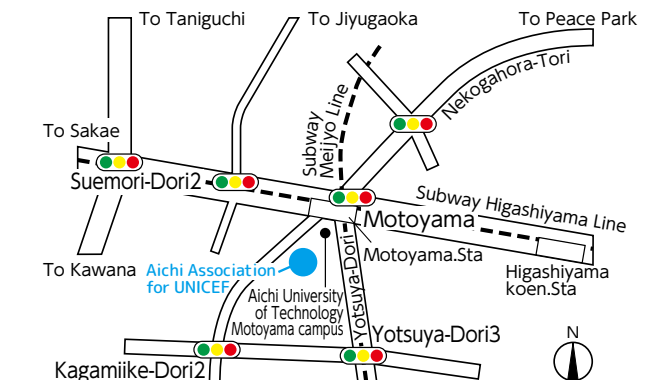

Activities

UNICEF Study Session

We hold UNICEF Study sessions at elementary, junior high, high schools, and special needs schools, focusing on global children's issues, children's rights, and UNICEF's activities. Additionally, sessions are available for corporate and organizational meetings or trainings, as well as for community-based learning.



Motoyama Exhibition Room Learning

At the Motoyama Exhibition Room, visitors can learn about UNICEF's work through panel displays and relief supplies. Students from elementary, junior high, and high schools, as well as university seminar groups, can also experience hands-on learning by seeing and touching these supplies.
